Student Course Requirements

- ❖ **Arrive** at 8.30am for a 9am start and class continues to approx 5.00pm
- ❖ Students to bring their own dogs
 - If a student is unable to bring their own dog (it could be age, cannot travel, is aggressive) – Please notify the course organiser
 - Bring **dog containments** for each dog (No sharing) – collar, lead, halti, harness, crates etc.
 - **No Aggressive dogs allowed**
 - **Dogs to be under control at all times – use collars / harness / halti / leads / crates**
- ❖ **What to bring – What to wear**
 - Pen and paper with something to lean on for writing
 - Fold up chair and cup if not provided
 - Suitable clothes for the weather conditions
 - Suitable closed shoes for walking / handling dogs – not loose slip on footwear – Safety
 - Doggy water bowls
 - Doggy treats – soft, small foods or strips that can be broken up into small pieces readily – bring a good quantity (Hard or big biscuits are not suitable). If using someone else's dog – please have owner's permission before using treats.
 - Sunscreen and sun hat if we go outside to work
 - Lunch and drinks etc
 - NO SMOKING inside buildings
