Student Course Requirements

- ❖ **Arrive** at 8.30am for a 9am start and class continues to approx 5.00pm
- ❖ Students to bring their own horses
 - If a student is unable to bring their own horse please notify the course organiser.
 - Bring halters, lead ropes (12ft long) rugs, hav/feed and water containers.
 - **No stallions or aggressive horses are allowed.**
 - **All horses must be quiet and able to be tied up safely in company.**
 - **Horses are to be in enclosed yards while not in use.**
 - There will be no horseriding on the day.
- ❖ **What to bring – What to wear**
 - Pen and paper with something to lean on for writing
 - Fold up chair and cup if not provided
 - Safe clothing suitable for handling horses – long trousers, polo or suitable work shirts, work boots. Bring clothes suitable for the weather conditions.
 - Water containers for horses and humans
 - Hay, hay nets and other feed needed by your horse for the day
 - Sunscreen and sun hat if we go outside to work
 - Lunch and drinks etc
 - NO SMOKING inside buildings
- ❖ **Full payment** of \$330.00 for the workshop and manual must be transferred to the nominated bank account of the course organiser on registration.
